

THE SOUND OF SILENCE

1. It has been clearly demonstrated to you that Yud-Hei-Vav-Hei is God. There is none beside Him (*ein od milvado*). (Deuteronomy 4:35)

Know therefore this day and keep in your heart that Yud-Hei-Vav-Hei is God in the heavens above and the earth below. There is none else (*ein od*). (Deuteronomy 4:39)

- 2. Do not follow other gods...consign their images to the fire. (Deuteronomy 6:14, 7:5)
- 3. It is a great achievement to make something out of Nothing; even greater is to make Nothing out of something. The goal of a spiritual life is to rearrange *ani* ("I"), spelled *alef-nun-yud* into *ayin* (nothing), spelled *alef-yud-nun*. For the ego to dissolve into the undifferentiated Nothing.
- 4. Wisdom comes forth from nothing (*ayin*). (Job 28:12)
