THE FLOW OF FREEDOM

- 1. You shall sound the shofar.... You shall consecrate (שָּקֶד) the fiftieth year. You shall proclaim liberty/release (קְרוֹר) throughout the land unto all the inhabitants thereof. It shall be a jubilee/yovel (יוֹבֵל) for you, and each of you shall return to your own holding and each of you shall return to your family. (Leviticus 25:9-10)
