REMOVING THE VEIL

- 1. God (*Elohim*) spoke to Moses and said, "I am Yud Hei Vav Hei. I appeared (*vaera*) to Abraham, Iasaac and Jacob as *El Shaddai*, but I was not known (בּוֹדְעָהִי) to them by My name Yud Hei Vav Hei....I have now heard the moaning of the Israelites... (Exodus 6:2-5)
- 2. בּוֹרְעְהִי "I did not inform them" is not written here but rather "I was not known to them." I was not recognized (לֹא נַכַרְתִי) by them in My aspect of trustworthiness, because of which I am named Yud Hei Vav Hei, that I am faithful that I may be relied upon to fulfill My words for I made them promises but have not yet fulfilled them. (Rashi Exodus 6:3)
 - is in the niphal verb stem: reflexive voice (subject both performs and receives the action) or passive voice (subject is acted upon)
- 3. Language was in exile, as long as they refused to receive the word of God, were not prepared to hear it. In the midrash we find, "They did not hear, because it was hard for them to separate from idolatry, as it is written, "They did not cast away the detestable things they were drawn to" (Ezekiel 20:8)....In order to hear one must be clear of all obstructions. This is the essence of exile, even now, that one cannot clear oneself of distractions and forget the vanities of the world. (Sefat Emet)
