WINGS OF HOPE

1. When Moses had finished the work, the cloud covered the Tent of Meeting, and the *kavod* of God filled (מלא) the Mishkan. (Exodus 40:33-34)

Moses said to Aaron...You shall not go outside the entrance of the Tent of Meeting for seven days, until the day that fulfills the days of your installation (עַד יוֹם מְלֵאת יָמֵי מְלֵאתֵיכֶם). (Leviticus 8:33)

2. None of you shall go forth from the entrance to your homes until morning...You shall observe this as matter as a rule for you and your children forever. (Exodus 12:22, 24)

That was for God a night of watching/expectation/vigilance (לַיְלִי שְׁמֵרִים). (Exodus 12:42)

You shall remain at the entrance of the Tent of Meeting day and night for seven days, keeping God's watch (וּשְׁמַרְתֶּם אֶת־מִשְׁמַרְתִּי יְהוָה). (Leviticus 8:35)

3. אָבִיו שָׁמַר אֶת־הַדְּבָר /his father [Jacob] waited for the matter/story/dream. (Exodus 37:11)

He waited in expectation for when it would come true, as in “awaiting fulfillment [of God's promise]” (Isaiah 26:2). (Rashi on Genesis 37:11)

4. As a spiritual person but especially as an artist – flow is my motto. Flow is the art of letting things happen; it is where the subconscious is leading the conscious, and where the apparent is giving way to the hidden. (Osnat Tazdok)
